The 1718 Sanctions Committee, if it has information that provides reasonable grounds to believe the vessels are or have been related to nuclear- or ballistic missile-related programmes or activities prohibited by relevant resolutions, may require any or all of the following measures with respect to vessels it designates pursuant to paragraph 12 of resolution 2321 (2016):

(a) the Flag State of a designated vessel shall de-flag the vessel;

(b) the Flag State of a designated vessel shall direct the vessel to a port identified by the Committee, in coordination with the port State;

(c) all Member States shall prohibit a designated vessel from entering their ports, unless in case of emergency, in case of return to the vessel's port of origination, or in case of direction by the Committee;

(d) a vessel designated by the Committee shall be subject to the asset freeze imposed in paragraph 8 (d) of resolution <u>1718 (2006)</u>.
