

**List of designated vessels prohibited from port entry pursuant to paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 2371 (2017) and paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 2375 (2017)**

The 1718 Sanctions Committee may designate vessels to be banned from port entry for activities prohibited by relevant resolutions, including transporting prohibited items from the DPRK, pursuant to paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 2371 (2017) and paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 2375 (2017), unless:

- entry is required in the case of emergency
- in the case of return to its port of origination
- the Committee determines in advance that such entry is required for humanitarian purposes or any other purposes consistent with the objectives of relevant resolutions
